Description of Events for New Families- April

4/1-5. – ACT Aspire Summative Test- given in grades 3-8th. This is the main test that the diocese provides for our school to get test scores that compare to the national and state. This test aligns with high school ACT test.

4/8 & 10- Cheer tryouts for grades 5-8

Dear Parents,

It is time for parents to apply for the First American Bank tuition loans for the 2019-2020 school year. If you are going to make a loan secured by the school, please notify the office, and we will send you a loan application. We will send all completed loan applications to First American Bank. All loans must be signed before May 9, 2019. The bank has notified us that the origination fee for your loan will be \$15.00 this year. The bank will contact you when it is time to sign your loan. Loans made after July 31 are not secured by the school.

Parents always have the option of obtaining their own loans from other financial institutions.

If you have decided not to do a loan, all money is due in the office by May 9, 2019 to avoid a late charge of \$250.00. The Parental Fee Acceptance Statement that is attached to this letter must be signed and returned with your loan application or with your tuition payment.

REFUNDS:

Registration and Student Fees are non-refundable. If a student leaves the school after tuition is paid or a loan application is signed, tuition will be refunded according to the following schedule.

Departure prior to June 1st --- 90% refund of tuition

Beginning June 1st, an additional 10% will be subtracted the first of each month thereafter.

LOANS:

A student tuition financing program is available to all parents. The bank selected by the school will finance up to 100% of the school year tuition and fees (not registration fees). Bank personnel will schedule loan signing in April and May.

Each school tuition loan will be amortized over a ten (10) month period with the first payment beginning July 1st. If a parent wishes their loan to be amortized over an eleven (11) month period, prior approval by the administration must be granted with the first payment beginning June 1st. Should any parent elect to pay cash for the tuition even after the note has been signed, he or she may do so at no charge before May 9th. After that date, a minimum \$25.00 prepayment charge will be assessed by the bank. All loans must be applied for and signed by May 9th since tuition is due on this date. Failure to meet this deadline will result in a late charge of \$250.00.

Any parent whose child is registered after July 31st and who wishes to participate in this program may do so. For parents who register after the deadline, the maturity date of April 1st will remain the same, and the number of months for amortization will be decreased accordingly.
