

# Tuition Reduction Incentive

In order to keep our school successful and tuition affordable we rely on fundraisers and events. It is impossible for our teachers and staff to be in charge of all the different fundraisers and events we present each year, so we rely on our parents and grandparents to help us out.

CHASA has again decided to offer the **TUITION REDUCTION INCENTIVE** this year! We will give our school families several ways to earn a chance at winning 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th place. **CONGRATULATIONS** to our previous winners!!!

The drawing will take place at the end of the school year. We will draw 4 names out of our raffle basket. A family can only win 1 of these places. If you will not be returning the next school year then you will forfeit the winnings – Except for an 8th grade family with no other children. Those families will receive a check in the amount that you have won. The next year's tuition must be paid in full or loan must be applied for in order to receive winnings. If a loan was used for tuition then winnings will be applied to bank loan.

- 1st place will receive \$1500 off of tuition for the next school year**
- 2nd place will receive \$1000 off of tuition for the next school year**
- 3rd place will receive \$500 off of tuition for the next school year**
- 4th place will receive \$250 off of tuition for the next school year**

Here are the ways to earn your name being entered into the drawings. You can choose 1 or more. Your name will be entered for EACH item listed below. For example: If you sign up for a classroom coordinator then your name will be entered once. If you sign up for a classroom coordinator and volunteer in the cafeteria then your name will be entered twice. If you do both of those and work your 6 family hours at the festival then your name will be entered 3 times. As far as the Activity Fee Plan, nothing will change. Your family will still earn the points listed in the Handbook. **You must fulfill the duties that come along with each item signed up for.**

- † Become a CHASA board member or School Board Member (When an opening becomes available)
- † Become a coach for a sport
- † Become a classroom coordinator
- † Be on a committee
- † Work your family's (2) 3 hour required time slots at the festival
- † Volunteer in the Cafeteria and Book Fair or just the Cafeteria (Must total at least 10 hours for the school year. Cafeteria and Book Fair hours can be combined)
- † Attend Back to School Night 8/28/2018 AND January Social (CHASA Dinner). These are important events that are very informational for our parents and important to our staff.
- † Volunteer for the campus workday (painting, pressure washing, trimming bushes, etc.) \*TBD

➤ Some families have a grandparent or another family member work in their place. This is acceptable and the hours worked will go toward that family's point system.
