St. Peter Chanel Spring Festival CHEFS' CHOICE COOK OFF OFFICIAL RULES Saturday, March 23rd @ 5PM

The following rules are to be followed by all participants and/or their assistants for the cook off.

1. Each contestant must enter their dish into one of the following categories:
 - a. Meat Entrée (Chicken, Pork, Beef or Wild Game)
 - b. Seafood Entree
 - c. Soup/Salad/Appetizer
2. Contestants must supply their own ingredients or secure a sponsor to pay for the ingredients. The contestants will also supply all of their own cooking and serving utensils.
3. Food may be cooked offsite but must be cooked on Saturday, March 23rd. All entries must be complete, delivered to St. Peter Chanel and ready to be served for judging at 5:00PM. Samples will be collected at 5:00PM. We will open to the public at 5:15PM.
4. Any chef wishing to cook on St. Peter Chanel's festival grounds is welcome to do so after 12PM on Saturday, March 23rd. **Cooking booths will be selected on a first come, first served basis.**
5. Any ingredient that accompanies a dish (such as rice or pasta) must be provided by the contestant if applicable. These items may be prepared offsite.
6. Each Contestant must cook a recipe that will serve 50 bowls of food. The food is considered a donation to the St. Peter Chanel Festival. The festival committee will provide bowls, knives, forks, spoons and napkins.
7. Contestants will be permitted to set up their equipment, decorations, and other facilities anytime after 12PM on Saturday, March 23rd.
8. Each contestant will be assigned a contestant's number by the chief scorekeeper and be given containers in which their entry will be collected for the official judging. Each contestant should make certain that the number on the bottom of the container is the same as the number on their sign. After the samples to be judged have been collected, an announcement will be made to start serving the public at approximately 5:15PM. Contestants or their designee must serve their dish until 7PM or until their pot is empty, which ever comes first.
9. A poster, identifying each chef, their entry and their sponsor shall be placed at each cooking booth.
10. First, Second, and Third place awards in each category will be awarded based on the results from a panel of judges. An overall "Peoples Choice" award will be awarded to the team who collects the most yellow tickets by 6:45PM that day.
